- 12<sup>th</sup> Convocation Ceremony: Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup> December 2025, starting at 9:00 a.m.
- 41st Graduation Ceremony: Friday, 19th December 2025, starting at 8:00 a.m.

## Prospective graduands should note the following:

- 1. Graduands List

- 2. Hiring of Graduation Gowns
- The fee for hiring a graduation gown is TZS 40,000 (non-refundable).
- Payment must be made using a control number generated in the graduand's SIMS (Student Information Management System) account.

- 3. Confirmation of Participation
- Confirmation Window opens on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2025 and closes on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2025.

- 4. Collection of Graduation Gowns
- Gowns will be issued at the Directorate of Academic Support Services
   Office from Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2025 to Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup>
   December, 2025.
- 5. Rehearsal
- A mandatory rehearsal for all graduands will be held on Thursday, 18
   December 2025 from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Graduands who will not attend the rehearsal will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.
- 6. Return of Graduation Gowns

Gowns must be returned to the Directorate of Academic Support Services Office between Monday, 22<sup>nd</sup> December 2025 and Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2026.

- Late returns will incur a penalty of TZS 30,000 per day.
- Failure to return the gown will result in a charge of TZS 300,000.
