● Strategic Partnerships for Financing Transport Infrastructure and Operations

Addresses transport economy analysis, collaborative investment models, risk-sharing frameworks, innovative financing approaches, and performance-based contracting to improve service delivery and infrastructure funding.

● Cross Cutting Issues in Transport and Logistics

Covers accessibility, rural connectivity, gender-responsive planning, transport governance, and transport's role in expanding access to jobs and essential services.

Any paper accepted for presentation but not presented during the conference will NOT appear in the official conference proceedings. Papers that appear to be the best after peer review will be published in the Journal of Logistics, Management and Engineering Sciences (JLMES).
